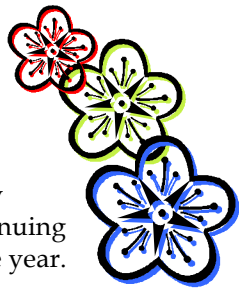
2011 Summer Enrichment Programs

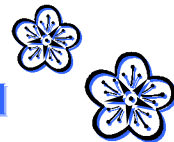
